



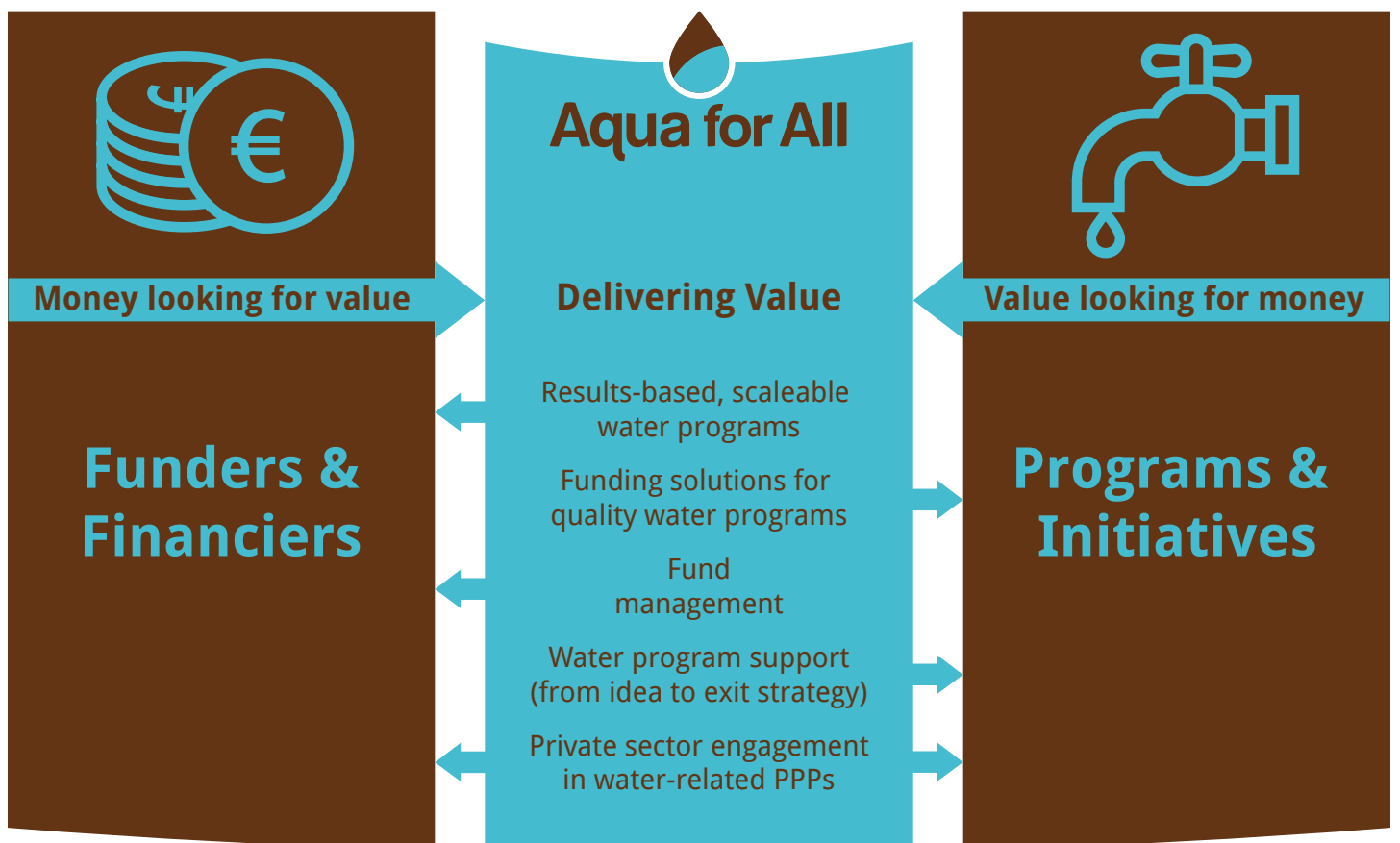

Where do we come from?

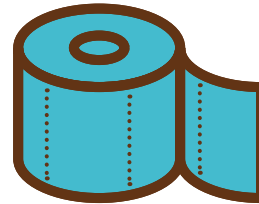

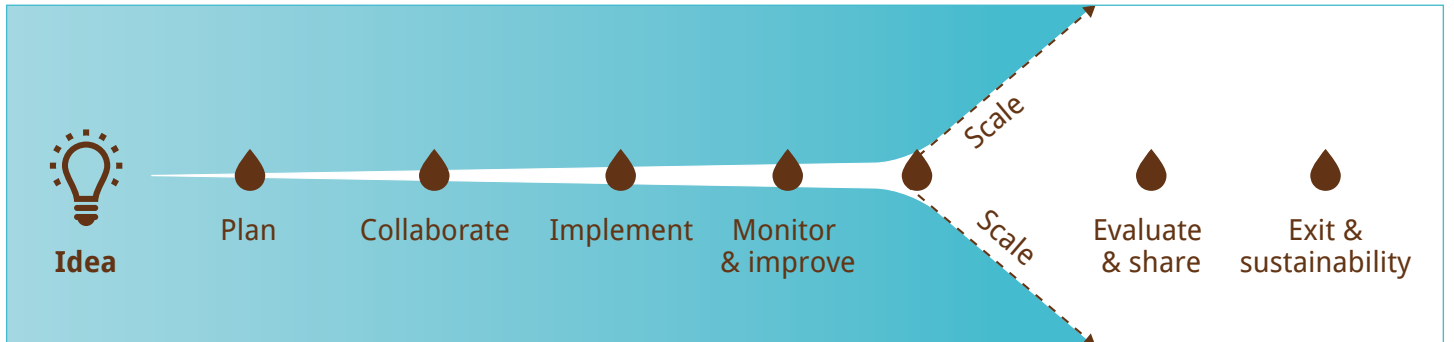
