The Governments of Kenya, Senegal and Ethiopia acknowledge the need for private funding to reach universal access to drinking water and sanitation. With the organisations in the panel we committed to reach over USD 860 million in investments and will discuss examples to facilitate investing in WASH.

<u>Highlight</u>: the **Water Access Acceleration Fund (W2AF)** will be launched by Incofin, with Danone (anchor investor) and Aqua for All (first loss provider).
