CATALYSING PRIVATE CAPITAL FOR WATER & SANITATION: ACCELERATING CHANGE

Event at the UN Water Conference, 24 March 2023, organised by Aqua for All and the Clinton Global initiative, hosted by ING New York

To accelerate access to safe drinking water and sanitation solutions, bridging the finance gap is a prerequisite that cannot be achieved without private investments. Aqua for All, a long-term partner of the Government of the Netherlands, plays an important role in catalysing private capital. Financial Inclusion will allow sustainable water enterprises, that play a vital role in complementing government efforts, to have access to investments and working capital.

The Governments of Kenya, Senegal, and Ethiopia, the National Bank of Kenya, La Banque Agricole, Aqua for All, and many other partners will showcase their efforts to build up investment portfolios. They will elaborate on how they contribute to the national water agendas and share their commitments to achieve SDG 6.

Specifically, the aim is to elaborate on the role of governments in creating an enabling environment for the water sector to thrive, and attract private investments. And ultimately inspire participants to replicate and accelerate innovative finance solutions for water and sanitation.

The participating banks, asset managers, and catalytic capital providers (de-risking) have committed to reaching over USD 860 million in allocations (portfolio build-up or investments) through blended finance solutions.
